	improvement story, innovation, or success on display. The deadline to submit proposals
	is Friday, February 7th.
	Please review this storyboard handbook before submitting your proposal.
	Before you submit your online application, please be certain it is in final format;
	you will be unable to make edits to already submitted applications. When you are
	ready to submit a final storyboard proposal in PDF format, <u>please click here</u> and fill in the
	required application fields. At the end of this process, you will be prompted to upload your
	required abstract in PDF format. IHI aims to respond to all storyboard proposals within two
	weeks of the day you submit your final application. If you have any questions regarding

Continuing education credits will not be awarded for non-educational activities, including (but not limited to) meals, breaks and receptions.

- 1. Go to <a href="www.IHI.org/certificatecenter">www.IHI.org/certificatecenter</a>. (If you are not logged into the website, you will be redirected to the log-in screen. Once you are logged in, you will be redirected back to the Certificate Center.)
- 2. Click on the "15<sup>th</sup> Annual International Summit" link that appears under the "Create Certificate" header.
- 3. Select the type of credits you wish to receive from the drop-down list and then click "Submit."
  - 4. Review your enrollment and click "Continue."
- 5. Take the surveys associated with each of the sessions you attended and for which you wish to receive credits by selecting "Take Survey Now" next to the session.
- 6. Once you have completed all of the associated surveys, "Generate Certificate" will be activated.
- 7. Click on this button to generate a PDF file of your certificate that you can print or save to your computer.

#### How do I edit the sessions I have selected OR enroll in new sessions?

- 1. Go to www.ihi.org and log in with your username and password
- 2. On the top right corner of the page, click "My IHI"
- 3. On the left column of your home page, click "My Enrollments & Certificates"
- 4. Under "15<sup>th</sup> Annual International Summit on Improving Patient Care in the Office Practice and the Community," click "Manage Orders"
- 5. To edit and select sessions, click on the blue button that says "View & Edit Order"
- 6. Under Selected Items, click "Edit"
  - To expand the offerings, click on the orange "+" button next to Minicourses, Learning Labs, etc. and the sessions will drop down.
  - To view the description, presenters, or objectives of a particular session, click on the title of the session.
- 7. Once you have selected your sessions, click the green "Checkout" button.
